### ANNOUNCEMENTS:-

1. All evening services offer the opportunity for Confession. The circumstances at the Bridge Chapel make it impossible to have long confessions before or during the Liturgy. We all take the Sacrament of Confession very seriously, and the faithful should ensure that everyone has the opportunity.
